BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Structured schedule including homework time, snack and free play

Morning Care 7:00am to 7:30am
Afternoon Care 3:00pm to 6:00pm

Kindergarten through 8th grade

MORNING PROGRAM

The cost for the morning program will be \$20.00 per week per family.

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

The cost for the afternoon program will be:

- 1 child - \$100 per month
- 2 children - \$175 per month (\$100 for first and \$75 for second child)
- 3+ children - \$235 per month (\$100 for the first, \$75 for second child, \$60 for third child and no cost for additional children)



The drop in rate is \$10.00 per student per day. The after school program cost includes a snack. The after school program will be billed at the end of each month.

NUTRITIONAL LUNCHESES

Lunches cost \$3.50 each. The food/salad bar is available daily with the entree or separate for \$2.50. Lunches must be pre-ordered monthly through SchoolSpeak. Menus are posted and ordered monthly. Menu items are prepared from scratch on site.
